***Guidelines for Case Management Practice

A report funded by a grant from The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation that presents the results of a fifteen-month project to develop practice guidelines for long-term care case management. Connecticut Community Care, Inc. (CCCI) established the National Advisory Committee on Long-Term Care Case Management, a group of case management experts from academia, provider organizations, and state and federal government. Guidelines in nine areas of case management were developed: Consumer Rights, Preferences and Values; Comprehensive Assessment; Care Plan; Implementation; Monitoring; Reassessment; Discharge and Termination; Quality of Case Management and Provider Services; and, Efficient Use of Resources.
